BASE INFORMATION

Select Non-Competitive

Permit Type: RPA (Ride Parks Australia)

Event Registration: RPA guidelines recommend to not restrict to club members

Age Category: Mini, Junior and Senior

Entries Close: Day before Event

Medical Services: RPA – *Ride Manager Name*

One Event Licences Accepted: You MUST tick this box to ensure the event shows up for unlicensed members to enter (Though they do not purchase one)

Entry Fee: \$15 (Clubs will be invoiced \$15 per participant for MAIL Insurance) *Please note, this \$15 fee will be added to the class fee that you will enter later on. If you intend on charging \$50 total for a senior, in the class fee you will put \$35.

CLUB LOCATION OFFICIALS

You are not required to add Officials to Ride Parks Australia Events but if your Ride Manager is an Accredited Official add them here. If they are not, you can continue without entering any official.

CLASSES

This is where you enter your classes and class fee.

Remember Ride Parks Australia Classes are dependant on Matched Ability, not Junior and Senior age groups.

When setting up a junior class fee, we recommend selecting all endorsements to make it user friendly (this will stop them getting a message saying they do not have the required endorsement).

If you cannot continue to Description page once adding Classes, Press EXIT. Go to Events, My Events, Update to continue to Description Tab

DESCRIPTION

This is where you outline a description of the event. Please see recommended wording below. You can also add in any specific club requirements here.

Please also attach the Ride Park Day Liability Waiver in here which will be emailed to each participant upon finalising their entry through Ridernet.

PRODUCTS

Here it is recommended clubs set up a product for the optional personal accident insurance that will be available as of the 1st of July for a price of \$15. This \$15 will then be invoiced to clubs.



You do not have an ACTIVE One Event Licence for the Event or an ACTIVE Annual Licence.

Would you like to purchase One Event Licence?

If you do not purchase a One Event Licence now you will need to come back into Ridernet before the event and purchase it or an annual licence.

One Event Licences are NOT required for Ride Parks Australia Events. Choose 'NOT THIS TIME'

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING minimum requirements: **

- Helmet – Any of the following approved standards is acceptable. AS1698, Snell, JIS, FIM, ECE.
- Clothing - Gloves, long sleeve jersey and long pants
- Body Armour - Recommended for Junior riders
- Off-road Boots ***
- Goggles/eye protection

** Protective clothing of acceptable standards is the responsibility of the rider.

*** - be constructed of leather or other similarly durable material; and
- be of a length which must at least overlap the trousers with the rider in a normal seated riding position on the machine.

Matched Ability:

- **Beginner:** This group is for riders that include children, parents and participants possibly new to motorcycle riding. It's to be managed at an appropriate speed to cater for the youngest or most novice of riders. The start straight run on a MX Track may present as an appropriate area for parents to teach their children how to ride.
- **Intermediate:** This group is for those who have sound motorcycle ability but possibly not ridden on tracks before. As with all groups, the intermediate group participation should be based on ability regardless of age.
- **Advanced:** The advanced group is ideal for those who frequent ride parks and possibly hold or have held a competition licence.
