Entries

There will be no entries on the day.

Tear Offs

Tear Off's are permitted at your venue and **must be disposed of in the bins provided.**

Camping

- Camping is available on Friday & Saturday nights.
- Gates will open from **12 noon Friday**. There will be a Parking Manager who will direct you to where you can camp, please follow all instructions on arrival.
- **\$25.00 PER VEHICLE as per supp regs** to be paid when entering the event online on. If you have not paid for this when you entered you must see Race Secretary at Sign on Area when you arrive, and you will be given a pass to display on the vehicle. If you don't do this you will be charged. Marshals will be checking to make sure every vehicle has a camping pass displayed on the front windscreen of the vehicle.
- Small fire pit buckets will be allowed at **night time only**. All fires must be out during racing.
- Please respect the club's venue and take all your rubbish with you when you leave.
- All children are to return to their own campsite by 8:30 each night.

- Noise curfew for each night is 10:00pm.

The Venue

- The complex is located at 60 Cowarra Access Road, Lake Innes NSW.
- Please note that the gate will open at 12:00 noon, Friday 19th May 2023. **Only committee members and officials will be allowed access before noon.**
- There are strictly **no animals allowed** at the venue with the exception of a Guide Dog. Anyone with pets will be asked to leave.
- This event is an **open pit** event. All bikes must be **ridden at walking pace** to and from your pit area, to your vehicle or camp area and from the exit lane when leaving the track.
- **Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times**
- **No** push bikes are allowed from 6:00am to the end of racing each day.
- **No** fireworks
- **On the spot fines will be issued or an exclusion from the event if you don't follow the rules.**
- Full canteen serving Breakfast, Lunch and snacks each day. Please support the club's canteen.

Please note that we will be following covid rules at the event we ask you to follow the below list:

- Masks can be worn at sign on area, canteen area if you wish.
- If you aren't feeling well, please leave the venue and let a key official know.

Sign On & Scrutineering.

- Friday: 3:00pm to 5:00pm
- Saturday: 6:00am to 7:30am

Schedule

- 8:15am Saturday: Riders briefing
- Practice will begin immediately after the riders briefing
- Racing will begin immediately after practice

Flag Marshals

Flag marshal sessions will be on display at sign-on. **Please remember that you must supply a marshal over the age of 16yrs to do your session.**

Thank you to all who are helping the club with this over the event.

Mechanics

Each rider is allowed one mechanic to go out on the start line with them. The mechanic must be over the age of 16 years. Mechanics must sign on. If you have not signed on you will not be allowed on the start line.

There is to be no assistance for riders from parents or flag marshals unless they are stuck under the machine OR should they sustain an injury/lack of consciousness. Parents are not permitted to assist their child with picking up their bike or starting their bike.

Racing

All classes will race on both Saturday and Sunday, racing will be as per the Supplementary Regulations and are subject to change due to the conditions on the day at the discretion of the key officials. Classes may be combined but will be scored separately. Please keep an eye out at sign on for changes to the race order.

Practice

- Practice will be 3 laps per class
- The first race will be by peg draw. Example: Peg 1 will have gate pick one and so on.
- All remaining races will be via finishing positions.

Timing

- Transponders will be used for the event. If you do not have your own bracket, you will need to purchase one for \$10.00 at Sign On.
- Please make sure to listen carefully in the Dummy Grid for your position.
- A count back will be used should there be a tie of final points at the end of scoring, with the rider scoring the best position in the last race being declared the higher position.

Please do not forget to return your transponders after you have finished racing to the sign on area.
