1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

Dargle Valley Motorcycle Club (DVMCC), hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct The Barry Cockle Classic (OPEN Event) at the Dargle MX MVRG, in conjunction with DVMCC Club Championship Round 5 on Sunday 22nd October 2023.

2. **JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The above-mentioned Open meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number **TBC** and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.
- 2.2. DAY LICENCES ARE ACCEPTED and processed via Ridernet at time of entry, cost of Day Licence is \$75.00, No Day Licences will be issued on the day. It is the competitor's responsibility to provide all the required documentation when purchasing the licence.
If you haven't held a MA Competition Licence in the last 10 years you will need to complete Competency Test – Please email race secretary info@darglemx.org.au prior to the event to obtain application and test

One Event Licence are issued under the following conditions.

- a) Proof of ambulance cover (mandatory)
- b) **For Juniors** – Current Endorsement in JCP Book or Kickstart Completed for CC Class Entering

If you have a Ridernet ID from a previous competition licence, coaches' licence, or an officials licence;

- Select Event Type: Open

2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. **ENTRIES:**

3.1 Entries open Monday 24th September and close **Thursday 19th October at 9pm**. On the day entries for this event will be permitted pending class availability

3.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.

3.3 Only entries received by RIDERNET (Online) that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

3.4 **NOTE: REFUNDS FOR WITHDRAWALS ARE AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE OR CLUB EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, AND AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.**

4. **INSURANCE:**

4.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

4.2 Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.

4.3 **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.**

5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

Will be provided by Event Health Services NSW with 2 Paramedics/First Responders in attendance for the duration of the event.

6. **ENTRY FEE:**

6.1 Junior Classes - \$60 First Class, 2nd Class \$20

Seniors Classes - \$70 First Class, 2nd /Additional Classes \$20

DVMCC Club members pricing will be discounted to standard club championship fees rather than above pricing

6.2 Payment to be made via Ridernet by ways of Debit or Credit Card only. Please note Ridernet has a small service fee payable in additional to entry fees

6.3 Please include a correct email address for confirmation of entry and any final instructions. FINAL INSTRUCTIONS will be emailed on Friday 20th October or if not before and posted to Barry Cockle Facebook Page

7. **ENTRY PASSES:**

Dargle Farm (Landholder) has an entry fee of \$5 per person or \$10 per vehicle payable on entry – Cash and EFTPOS is available. This fee is not part of the entry fee. All proceeds go to the Cockle Family.

Camping is available Saturday Night and \$20 fee is payable at the gate directly to Dargle Farm (Landholder). This fee is not part of the entry fee. All proceeds go to the Cockle Family.

8. **CLASSES OF COMPETITION:**

JUNIORS

- 50cc Div 1 Non-Competitive (Nippers)
- 50cc Div 2
- 65cc 7-u12
- 85cc 9-u12
- 85cc 12-u16
- Junior Lites 125cc 2 Stroke
- Junior Lites 250cc 4 Stroke

SENIORS

- MX1 (All Powers)
- MX2 (up to 250cc)
- MXV - Veterans Over 45s
- MXW – Women
- Has Beens (Period 20)

9. **AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:**

All Juniors 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in above classes of competition with exception of 50cc Div 1 (Nippers) will be awarded with trophies or alike

All 50cc Div 1 Non-Competitive (Nippers) participants will receive a Medallion/Trophies of equal value

All Seniors 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in above classes of competition will be awarded with trophies or alike

There is no Prize Money for this event in any Junior or Senior Classes

10. **ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

- 10.1 **For all Championship classes, the number of entries received at the closing date will determine if the number is sufficient to constitute a championship. The closing date for entries will not be extended and if there are insufficient numbers, that class will not be run as a championship.**
- 10.2 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be **6** for each class of competition.
- 10.3 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prize money, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.

11. **RACE FORMAT:**

11.1 **All Juniors**

50cc Div 2, 65cc, 9-U12 85cc – 2 Laps Practice, 3 Rounds of 3 Lap Races
12-U16 85cc, Juniors Lites 125cc and 250cc - 2 Lap Practice, 3 Rounds of 4 Lap Races
50cc Nippers 4 sessions of 5 mins

All Seniors

MX1, MX2, MXV, MXW, Has Beens – 2 Laps Practice, 3 Rounds of 5 Lap Races
Barry Cockle Classic Feature Race – 8 Laps

- 11.2 Scoring will be as per DVMCC Club Bylaws. i.e. 35 points will be allocated to the overall 1st place at the end of each moto, 32 pts for 2nd place, 30 pts for 3rd place, 28 points for 4th place, 26 points for 5th place, etc, to be accumulated over the 3 rounds, with the maximum possible being 105 points achieved per class for the series.

DVMCC club members will be awarded points as per club championship scoring

***Bonus Scoring for Barry Cockle Classic Feature Race Only** (added to Final MX Scoring), Either/Or Apply ie you can receive both points for age and bike

Age

- 18-24 – 0 Points
- 25-30 – 1 Point
- 31-39 – 3 Points
- 40-49 – 5 Points
- 50 + - 6 Points

Bike

- Modern – 0 Points
- Pre 2001 – 1 Point
- Pre 95 – 2 Points
- Pre 90 – 3 Points
- Pre 85 – 5 Points
- Evo – 7 Points
- Pre 78 – 8 Points

***In the event of a tie for 1st Place with points for the Barry Cockle Classic – The WINNER will be deemed the rider on the oldest bike.**

- 11.3 Results will remain “Provisional” until ratified and confirmed by Motorcycling NSW.
11.4 If the meeting is a Championship, all championship classes will take precedence over support classes.

12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR’s for Motocross competition.
12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
12.3 Change of machine is permitted when the Clerk of Course has been notified of the change
12.4 Noise &/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.

13. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1 Competitors will be allocated their Motorcycling NSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred riding number if available. All others shall be allocated numbers at the DVMCC discretion.
13.2 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR’s.

14. GRID POSITIONS:

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders’ briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and all participants MUST attend. Riders’ briefing sign-on sheets must be signed or Check-in via Ridernet by the competitor as confirmation of attendance.

16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

17. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR’s) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

18. TIMETABLE:

Gates Open: Saturday afternoon from 3pm and Sunday 6am
Sign on: 7am to 8am
Scrutineering: 7am to 8am
Riders Briefing: 8:30am
Start of Practice: 9am
Start of Racing: At the completion of Practice

For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 6am Saturday 9th September with the completion of the meeting for the participant being at the completion of racing on Sunday 10th September.

19. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

The track is a natural terrain with man-made jumps and is run in an anti-clockwise direction. The Track is Approximately 1.9kms in length consisting of both soft and hard packed soil and has been licenced as per the MA Track Guidelines.

20. STARTS:

15/5 Sec Board with 40 Backward Drop Gates (self-penalizing)

21. RACING:

Practice – all classes 2 laps

50cc Div 2, 65cc, 9-U12 85cc – 3 Rounds of 3 Lap Races
 12-U16 85cc, Juniors Lites 125cc and 250cc - 3 Rounds of 4 Lap Races
 MX1, Mx2, MXV, MXW, Has Beens – 3 Rounds of 5 Lap Races
 Barry Cockle Classic Feature Race – 8 Laps
 50cc Nippers 4 sessions of 4 mins.

22. NOISE:

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's and the track licence. Bikes must not be started till 9am each day.

23. PAYG WITHHOLDING TAX:

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

24.1	Presentations etc.	At the conclusion of racing
24.2	Facilities:	Full canteen will be open from 7am, serving breakfast and lunch. Coffee Van. Food Truck available for dinner Saturday night, Toilets and Hot Showers
24.3	Marshaling:	ALL riders are required to provide a marshal, this is compulsory and a condition of entry. If you are unable to provide a marshal you will not take the grid. All marshals are to be over 16 years of age
24.4	Tyres:	n/a
24.5	Admission Charges:	\$5 per person or \$10 per car, collected at gate when entering track payable direct to Dargle Farm (Landholder). This is not included in your entry fee. All proceeds go to the Cockle Family.
24.6	Camping:	Is available Saturday evening and payable direct to Dargle Farm (Landholder) on Entry – Cash or Eftpos Available. This is not included in your entry fee. \$20 per family. All proceeds go to the Cockle Family.
24.7	Injuries:	All injuries <u>MUST</u> be reported to the Clerk of the Course
24.8	Pit Area:	No riding of machines is allowed in the pit area, any breach may result in exclusion of the corresponding competitor from the meeting. Only rider and mechanic are allowed in the pit area. Pushbikes and scooters are not allowed in the pit area. ENCLOSED FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
24.9	Car Park:	Riding of machines in the car park is not permitted. All bikes must be walked out from the pit area to the car park.
24.10	Animals:	Animals are not permitted within the confines of the complex unless they are registered assistance animals. Anyone found to have brought an animal onto the premises will be asked to leave.
24.11	Score Tower:	The score tower is off limits to all persons. Exemptions will be made to officials of the meeting.
24.12	Electronic Communications & Social Media Policy	All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's electronic communication and social media policy found at www.ma.org.au which sets out a framework for acceptable online behavior where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons.
