#### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The TAMWORTH MOTORCYCLE CLUB hereafter called the Promoter will conduct NSW Senior & Junior Speedway Solo CHAMPIONSHIPS for Speedway at Oakburn Park Tamworth on SATURDAY 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2023

1.1 Supplementary Rain off schedule: If the meeting has been postponed for the reason of force majeure the date will be 9<sup>th</sup> December 2023 If the rain date cannot be run in its entirety, but the meeting has reached 75% for all competitors, then a result may be declared by the steward based on the points at the time of the determination. If it has not reached 75%, then the event will be declared null and void and further decisions of status of this event are at the discretion of Motorcycling Australia.

## 2. JURISDICTION

- 2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by MNSW which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number\_\_\_\_\_and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia MA Licenses.
- 2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by MNSW. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

#### 3. EVENT OFFICIALS

#### 4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Entries are now open via Mail or Email and close last mail will be 24th November 2023 Late entries will not be accepted.
- 4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Tamworth Motorcycle Club if such retention is approved by MNSW
- 4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form will be accepted.
- 4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs Tamworth Motorcycle Club, in writing, 10 days before the event. A medical certificate is required if a rider withdraws less than 10 days before the event.

#### 5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 Senior Solo	1 <sup>st</sup> class \$80	Pay on the day of racing
Junior Solo	1st class \$60	Pay on the day of racing
Support Class	ses 1st class \$70	Pay on the day of racing

- 5.2 Payment is to be made at sign on the day of racing please do not send any money through the post. Any fees for dishonored cheques will be the responsibility of the entrant.
- 5.3 Payment is to be done on the day of racing at sign on you will still need to fill in your entry form and email **to joslade57@hotmail.com**.

#### 6. ENTRY PASSES

No passes will be given everyone who enters your name passengers name, and 1 mechanic name will be at the gate upon your arrival to Oakburn Park.

#### 7. INSURANCE

- 7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance



#### 8. MEDICAL SERVICES

Beneficial & Safety Paramedics will be in attendance on the day of racing.

#### 9. SCRUTINEERING

- 9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 2pm and will finish at 4pm
- 9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined.
- 9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.
- 9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Steward can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.
- 9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and scrutineered will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

#### 10. CLASSES OF COMPETITION

Senior & Junior Championship Classes Senior Speedway Solo 500cc Open Junior Speedway Solo 125cc Open

Non-Championship Support Classes

Senior Speedway Sidecar maximum 6 riders

Junior 250cc Speedway Sidecars maximum 4 riders

Junior 250cc Speedway Solo maximum 8 riders

Over 35 Speedway Solos Evo and Modern

If more than 10 riders enter in any of the support classes Tamworth MCC will select the riders from final nominations

## 11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

11.1 To constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be.

Senior Speedway Solos will be 8

Junior 125cc Speedway Solos will be 6

If more than 18 Speedway Solos nominate there may be a time trial or a series of heats depending on the final numbers entered. Qualifying maybe on the Saturday the 2<sup>nd of</sup> December 2023 if needed.

If a qualifier is to be used the top 8 seeded riders will be from last year's Championship in order of finishing.

And, if a race off is to be used it will be selected by the MNSW Speedway Committee.

11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the Tamworth Motorcycle Club, subject to MNSW approval

#### 12. STARTS AND FINISHES

Starts will be done with slide up Speedway type tapes any rider who touches the tapes will be excluded from that race. Finishing will be done by Checkered flag.

## 13. FLAGS AND SIGNALS

Red & Green lights will be used around the track as well as yellow flags on each corner of the track.



#### 14. RACE FORMAT

Support races will be 3 Heat rides and 1 B Final and 1 A Final

Championship Solo classes will be the 20-heat format with (1) 5 rider B Consolation Final and (1) 5 rider A Final Top 4-point scorers go straight to A Final and 1<sup>st</sup> place from B Final will go into A Final.

MNSW Medallion and Prize money for  $1^{st}-2^{nd}$  -  $3^{rd}$ . for each championship class overall. Points for each round are as below.

#### 15. EVENT SCHEDULE

- Riders Briefing 4.15pm
- Practice straight after Rider's briefing
- Racing straight after Practice

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be at 1pm with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

## 16. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY

## Seniors Championship Classes 1st 2nd 3rd 4th

Senior 500cc Speedway Solo will be \$20 a point for heats only.

Senior 500cc Speedway Solo will be A Final 1st \$2000 2nd \$400 3rd \$200 4th \$100.

No money to be paid for B Consolation Final

Junior Speedway Solos Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th places.

## Non-Championship Support Classes

All support classes will receive trophies for 1st 2nd and 3rd

## **17. PAYG**

PAYG Withholding affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 46.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

## 18. PRESENTATIONS

Will be done at the canteen after the race meeting.

## 19. MACHINES AND RIDERS

- 19.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Speedway competition.
- 19.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 19.3 Change of machine is permitted



#### 20. RIDING NUMBERS

Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Tamworth Motorcycle Club discretion.

All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required MA decal.

## 21. GRID POSITIONS

Grid positions will be pre- drawn and printed in the program.

#### 22. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

#### 23. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

The Oakburn Park Tamworth is granite sand approximately 450 meters in length and the bikes will race Bi Directional.

#### 24. TRACK INSPECTION

All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

#### 24.1 Track Dissatisfaction

Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of Course if those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the meeting.

#### 25. FACILITIES

Toilets Showers also have Wheelchair access and Canteen are all available on the day.

#### 26. NOISE

All machines MUST comply with the requirements of the GCRS and track license anyone failing to do this will be excluded from the race meeting.

Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course. Refer to speedway for details.

#### **27. TYRES**

Knobby rear tyres are not permitted on any bike Junior or Senior.

### 28. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

28.1 All competitors, crew, parents / guardians and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia.

28.2 Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements they should visit the website <a href="https://www.sportintegrity.gov.au">www.sportintegrity.gov.au</a>

It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MA, until the results of the tests are known.

## 29. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

All competitors and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to MA website for details on the Safety Policy – Drug and Alcohol testing.



## 30. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behaviour contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at <a href="www.ma.org.au">www.ma.org.au</a> which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. These Codes of Behaviour apply to this meeting and will be enforced.

## 31. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

All riders must have a minimum 2kg, dry powder A:B (E) class, working fire extinguisher in their pit area. If any rider turns up without their fire extinguisher they will be made go and buy one.

## 32. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA

All competitors, officials and parents are bound by of MA's Social Media Policy, found at <a href="www.ma.org.au">www.ma.org.au</a>, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behavior where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons, penalties may apply for breaches of the policy.

## 33. ADMISSION CHARGES

- Adults 16 years and over are \$25
- Children 9 to U16 years & Pensioners are \$15
- Children 8 years and under are free
- Camping will be \$30 per site.

## 34. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

All teams and riders are responsible for the removal of all items including rubbish from their pit area as they vacate the premises. Penalties may apply as per GCR 6.1.1.1 a)

Used tyres cannot be left on site. Any rider found to have left tyres in the pit area will be fined for the cost of their disposal. All riders must use their environmental mat under their bike to catch any oil spillage.

Oil bins will be put around the pits to put all used oil from bikes in please do not tip your oil on the ground.

34. DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC INFORMATION All Championship Classes will be 4 Laps. All Support Classes will be 3 Laps
