

# VENUE CLOSURE STATE TITLE HOSTS POLICY

**Title:** Venue Closure State Title Hosts

**Authority:** This document is a policy made pursuant to the Motorcycling NSW Constitution. MNSW may unilaterally introduce, vary, remove or replace this policy at any time.

## 1. Policy

This policy is to be utilized in conjunction with the General Competition Rules listed within the Manual of Motorcycle Sport.

Any club who is awarded a State Championship round (Speedway & Road Disciplines excluded) must comply with the following venue restrictions:

- That the entire track and any part thereof will be closed for all motorcycle activity for a period of 21 days prior to a State Championship round being held on that track. Motorcycle riding is prohibited on that track for the time including social recreational, permitted, or unpermitted.
- The period of closures will be taken from the first date on the permit as listed in the Supplementary regulations.

## 2. Rationale

To ensure that all clubs have adequate time to prepare that venue to a standard befitting a State Championship round.

Restrictions are placed upon the track being used for the State Championship and any part thereof, not the venue on which the circuit is located. Other tracks within the venue are permitted to be used during the restricted period.
