Subject: Updated Permit Conditions

Motorcycling NSW would like to inform all affiliated clubs that Motorcycling Australia has released new permit conditions, which will take effect from **1st February 2025**. These updated conditions apply to all permitted events, including competition, recreational, and non-riding activities.

Key Updates:

- **Permit Conditions:** The revised conditions outline specific requirements for various event types, including competition and recreational events. These include updates to official accreditation levels, participant caps, medical requirements, and event classifications.
- **Officials & Governance:** Minimum levels of key officials have been updated for different event sizes, ensuring compliance with national regulations.
- **Event Regulations:** Adjustments have been made to permit lengths and licensing conditions for clubs and promoters.
- **Exclusion Periods:** Events must adhere to the updated scheduling rules, including restrictions on events within eight days of State Championships events on the same track.
